Programs/Events

- Family Story Time

Current Projects

- Relabeling Adult Fiction Section
 - After receiving feedback from patrons and volunteers we have determined we will leave the adult fiction section as is for the time being rather than separating it into sub-genres (i.e., mystery, romance, science fiction, western, etc.) We are however, in the process of slowly relabeling the entire collection so all labels within the collection are consistent. This will make it

easier for our patrons to find what they are looking for, and it will also make it easier for our volunteers when they are reshelving the books.

• Inventory and Weeding

• The librarians have been prepping and training to begin a huge weeding and inventory project in the month of January.

• Computer Room Upgrades

• The library is currently working with the Town of Edgewood IT department to upgrade all the computers in the computer room. They have been running extremely slow for a vey long time, and we are getting that fixed very soon.

Other News

- The library currently still has two vacant positions on the Library Advisory Board.
- The roof in the library has been fixed! Yay! No more risking damage to the books due to roof leaks!
- The "Friends of the Library" group desperately needs volunteers to help in the book barn. Anyone interested in volunteering should contact the library to get the group directors contact information.
- The library now has a TI-84 Plus graphing calculator available for in library use!
- The library used the remainder of our ARPA Grant funds to order signage for the outside of the library building to make it easier for patrons to find us.
