• Relabeling Adult Fiction Section

 We are currently getting feedback from patrons and volunteers to determine if we should leave the adult fiction section as is or separate it into sub-genres (i.e., mystery, romance, science fiction, western, etc.) Once we have determined what will work best for our community, we will relabel the entire collection to reflect those needs.

Library Outdoor Signage

• We have been told by our patrons for an extremely long time that it is extremely difficult to find the library since there is no signage on the roadways or building. The only signage we have as of right now is a small green road sign with a book on it on NM-344. We want to fix this and have been getting quotes for signage to make it easier for our patrons to find us.

• Computer Room Upgrades

 The library is currently working with the Town of Edgewood IT department to upgrade all the computers in the computer room. They have been running extremely slow for a vey long time, and we are getting that fixed very soon.

- The library currently still has two vacant positions on the Library Advisory Board.
- The "Friends of the Library" group desperately needs volunteers to help in the book barn. Anyone interested in volunteering should contact the library to get the group directors contact information.
- Edgewood Community Library received our State Grants and Aid Grant Agreement for FY-23 and will be receiving \$10,254.72 for the 2022-2023 FY.
- We finally have lighting on the outside of the library building thanks to the Town of Edgewood
 Maintenance Department! This is extremely helpful especially during these winter months when it gets
 dark several hours before the library closes.
