



TOWN OF EDGEWOOD **SNOW RESPONSE PLAN**

Weather forecasts issued by the National Weather Service or other reporting agencies are considered to determine an appropriate response to a storm.

NMDOT maintains and is responsible for **NM 333, NM 344, NM 472 and Interstate 40**; The Town of Edgewood may provide support in assisting with snow removal of these roads, but they remain the sole responsibility of NMDOT.

TOWN ROADS: If the snow storm develops during regular working hours (Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.), the Roads Manager dispatches personnel and equipment as needed. If a storm develops outside regular working hours, on-duty police officers are responsible for calling the Roads Manager who will dispatch personnel and equipment.

PRIORITIES: In case of snow accumulation on roads in the Town of Edgewood, our priority will be to clear snow blockages from arterial roads first. Arterial roads are those roads whose primary function is to deliver traffic from local streets to highways and the freeway. The arterial roads identified as emergency transportation routes receive attention first, followed by the arterial roads identified as school bus routes (during the school year). Residential and local access roads are serviced only after arterial and collector routes have been cleared. Listing and prioritizing the roads to be cleared does not mean all those roads will be cleared.... If snow falls and accumulates throughout the day, the Road Crew may not be able to clear all the priority roads. It's important to note that while the Town of Edgewood Road Department is responsible for clearing town roads, private roads and driveways are off limits except in the case of a life-threatening emergency, whereby circumstances require emergency responders to have access to a residence.
